

Establishment Closures in Ohio, 2009

In 2009, there were 57 establishment closures identified by the Mass Layoff Statistics (MLS) Program resulting in 11,693 separations among establishments with pre-closure employment of 50 or more employees. Manufacturing accounted for 50.1 percent of the separations followed by Transportation with 17.5 percent. Closures represented 10.1 percent of the total mass layoff events (562) and 10.2 percent of the total separations (114,879).

Overall, 30 of the 88 counties in the state experienced establishment closures as defined by the MLS Program. Clinton, Franklin, and Montgomery counties' closures included more than 1,000 separations each.
