Mass Layoff Events in Ohio 1st Quarter 2011


During the period January through March 2011, there were 64 mass layoff events in Ohio, a decrease of 26 events from the 1st Quarter of 2010. This resulted in 9,615 separations, a decrease of 6,616 from the 1st Quarter 2010 total of 16,231 separations. Included in the 64 events were 7 establishment closures/partial closures of single or multiple worksites with 1,495 separations. This compares to 8 establishment closures and 1,503 separations from a year ago.

Events by Industry

Construction out paced all with 31% of the total number of mass layoff events and 21% of all separations. Manufacturing followed with 30% of the total events and represented 36% of all separations.




Events by Primary Reason
